## **Important Notes**

- \*The maximum number of credits that can be awarded based on proficiency test results is six for English and Japanese combined.
- \*Awarded credits under this system shall be included in the maximum of 60 other university credits that may be recognized by Nagoya University.
- \*Additionally, those who wish to apply this program should meet either one of the following requirements:
- 1. Those who have already earned the N1, N2 or N3 of JLPT before entering Nagoya University.
- 2. Those who got certified as the person to have an ability of N2 or more for JLPT at the result of the Placement Test. Furthermore, took and passed a test of JLPT in December of the same year.
