Important Notes

*The maximum number of credits that can be awarded based on proficiency test results is six for English and Japanese combined.

*Awarded credits under this system shall be included in the maximum of 60 other university credits that may be recognized by Nagoya University.

*Additionally, those who wish to apply this program should meet either one of the following requirements:

1. Those who have already earned the N1, N2 or N3 of JLPT before entering Nagoya University.
2. Those who got certified as the person to have an ability of N2 or more for JLPT at the result of the Placement Test. Furthermore, took and passed a test of JLPT in December of the same year.

*About necessary credits of Japanese language for completion, please consult the Japanese course instructor.

2. Applying

Application Process

- ① Log in NUCT (<https://ct.nagoya-u.ac.jp/portal/>), click “Membership” on the left tab and click “Joinable Sites”, and then click “Join” on “Recognition of Credits”.
- ② Click “Recognition of Credits based on English Proficiency test Scores” on “My Current Sites”.
- ③ Go to “Tests & Quizzes” and click “<<For International Programs Students>>Recognition of Credits based on Japanese Language Proficiency Test Scores” from “Take an Assessment” and start assessment.
- ④ Attach the following documents in NUCT
 1. Copy of the JLPT Certificate
 2. Copy of an Authorization Letter to authorize Nagoya University to confirm the authenticity of the certificate. The letter can be downloaded from NUCT > Resources. Print it out and fill in the date, your name and address and sign it.
 3. Copy of your passport or other personal identification document with photo
- ⑤ Click “Submit for Grading” when you answer.
※Your finished task will be appeared on “Submitted Assessments”.

3. Results

Awarded credits can be checked on NU portal from July 3, 2020. (This date could change.)

Those credits shall be considered credits gained in the semester the application was made. The grade will be either pass or fail and not be reflected in the GPA.
